

# ADVERBIEN der ART UND WEISE --- ADVERBS of MANNER

“Mrs Smith is a careful driver. She drives .....”

“Jim is angry. Jim shouts .....”

“Her English is horrible. She speaks .....”

“His English is fantastic. He speaks .....”

„Tony is a good player. He plays .....”

→ Adverbien (der Art und Weise) geben an, **wie** man etwas **tut**.

→ Adverbien beziehen sich auf das **Verb**

→ Adverbien werden so gebildet:

> “normale” Adjektive: Adjektiv + -ly (nervous + -ly = nervously)

> Adjektiv auf -le: Adjektiv ohne -le + -ly (horrib-le + -ly = horribly)

> Adjektiv auf -y: -y wird zu i + -ly (angry + -ly = angrily)

> Sonderfall „good“: Form des Adverbs ist „well“

> Ausnahmen ohne Veränderung: far, fast, free, hard, high, late, left, long, near, right, straight ahead, wrong

“This car drives ..... It is a ..... car.” (fast)

“The train arrives ..... The train is .....” (late)

“This text is ..... I can understand it .....” (easy)

“It rains ..... This is ..... rain. (heavy)
